

Wolf letter December 2025 - Comms pack

Context: On December 17, we will publish a letter to environment ministers calling to not increase the killing of wolves. The letter will come out about a year after the Bern Convention decision, which is where the European Commission spearheaded a disinformation political campaign against wolves, defied scientific advice and lowered the much-needed protection of a whole species.

This letter, signed by 213 organisations across Europe and beyond, calls on EU Member States:

- Not to lower the protection status of the wolf on their respective national territory
- To ensure robust and science-based reporting on the conservation status of the species
- To support co-existence between wolves and local communities

We will send the letter to all EU Environment and Agriculture Ministers on Wednesday, 17 December, in the morning. You can start posting about the letter as of <u>17 December, 11am CET</u>.

One year ago, Europe signed away the right to live for wolves. All politics - no consideration of science, conservation experts, and hundreds of civil society organisations.

This is more than a policy choice - it's a moral responsibility. The eyes of citizens and future generations are on you. Defend science. Defend nature. Defend people.

Some countries are standing up for wolves and for nature. Is yours? The iconic wolf has officially lost its 'strictly protected' status under EU law. This decision was made without scientific evidence.

But not all countries are giving in. Several have rejected this move and are choosing to defend nature. Real leadership means following science, not politics. For this reason, more than 200 organisations across Europe call on EU countries to stand up for the wolf!

EU countries have received significant funding to support coexistence with large

carnivores. These tools work and are funded - from prevention to compensation - but many remain underused.

Weakening protection is not the answer. Using the tools we already have is.

The wolf is not the problem. The real threat is choosing political quick wins over lasting solutions for nature, climate and our future. Let's lead in protection, and call on others to do the same.
